Part-Time Handwork Teacher (posted 11/27/18).

This is an hourly position teaching handwork in first and second grade, for three 1-hour classes per week. Competency in knitting is required. It would be helpful to have a working knowledge of wool preparation (washing, carding, hand-spinning etc.), plant dying fibers, and felting. This position includes organizing materials and planning lessons for teaching classes of up to 24 students. Classes over 12 students will have an assistant.

Prior background in working with children and special interest in Waldorf education is necessary. Experience in a Waldorf program is preferred. This is an excellent opportunity for a recent graduate of a Waldorf Teacher Training program, who is seeking classroom experience. Applicants must be dedicated to excellence in teaching and recognize the importance of collegial cooperation.
