High School German Position Opening for Fall, 2019 (posted 03/05/19 - Accepting applications until 03/25/19)

Maine Coast Waldorf School is seeking a high school German teacher for the 2019-2020 school year. This position is full time. An undergraduate degree, foreign language teaching experience, and an interest in Waldorf education are required. Teacher training in Waldorf Education is highly desirable.

Maine Coast Waldorf School has a strong international exchange program. Over half of our students will have studied abroad by the time they graduate.

Some of the responsibilities of this position include:

- Creating and implementing a grade appropriate high school German curriculum that is consistent with Waldorf Education
- Serving as director of the international exchange program, co-coordinating with the high school French teacher.
- Serving as a class advisor, individual student mentor, chaperone for overnight class trips and various other duties related to teaching.

Half-Time Handwork Teacher for Fall 2019 (posted 02/05/19)

Maine Coast Waldorf School is offering a half-time position for a Handwork teacher in grades 1-4 for the Fall of 2019. Skills needed include knitting, crocheting, hand sewing, embroidery, and cross-stitch. It would be helpful to have a working knowledge of wool preparation (washing, carding, hand-spinning etc.), plant dying fibers, felting, and basic color theory. This position includes organizing materials and planning lessons for teaching classes of up to 24 students. A Bachelor's degree is required. Prior background in working with children and special interest in Waldorf education is necessary. Experience in a Waldorf program is preferred. This is an excellent opportunity for

a recent graduate of a Waldorf Teacher Training program, who is seeking classroom experience. Applicants must be dedicated to excellence in teaching and recognize the importance of collegial cooperation.

Preferred applicants would have an undergraduate or advanced degree in mathematics, science, technology or engineering. We especially welcome applicants who have completed (or who are in the process of completing) Waldorf Teacher Training. Applicants must be committed to collaborative work with colleagues and families, as well as to working in an environment that fosters the education of the whole human being. This position primarily includes teaching upper level topics in mathematics, as well as topics in earth sciences and/or life sciences. Additional responsibilities include chaperoning student trips, various in-school supervisions, and possibly coaching or offering other after-school activities.

Salary and Benefits: Faculty working at 80% of full-time or higher are currently offered medical and disability coverage, a retirement plan, and financial support for professional development.
